This / These

We use this (singular) to talk about things close to us.
(Only one thing or uncountable)

This board is white.

This marker doesn't write well.

THIS



Singular, Near

We use these (plural) to talk about things close to us.
(Two things or more, countable)

These markers are colorful.

These cadets don't like getting up early.

THESE



Plural, Near

That / Those

We use that (singular) to talk about things far from us.
(Only one thing or uncountable)

That window isn't clean.

That water is brown. Don't drink it.

THAT



Singular, Far

We use those (plural) to talk about things far from us.
(Two things or more, countable)

Those books are green.

Those officers love giving snacks to cadets.

THOSE



Plural, Far

Structure

These + Plural nouns

Those + Plural nouns

Here



Here = in this place, near me.

Examples:

My book is here.

I live here.

Come here, please.

There



There = in that place, not near me.

Examples:

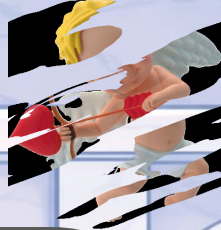
The shop is there.

Put the bag there.

We never go there.

Grammar!

Over here / Over there



We can use 'over' before here and there to add emphasis!

Examples:

You can read the rules over here.

Put your books over here.

That person over there is my cousin.

Those plants over there are really ugly.

	singular	uncountable	plural
things near me (here)	this map	this pasta	these dishes
things not near me (there)	that book	that cheese	those cups

We can also use *this*, *that*, *these*, *those* with no noun after it.

This is the living room.

What's **that** in English?

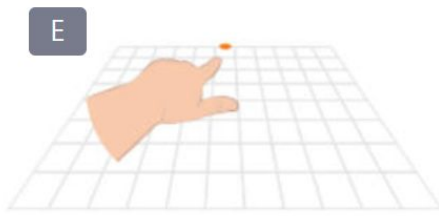

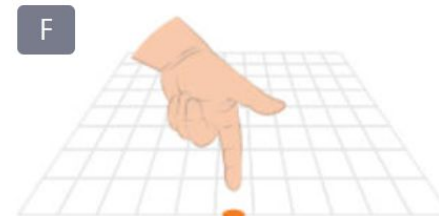

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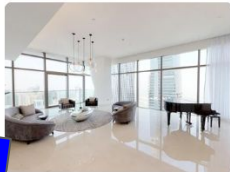
