

ANNEX 34A**FORMAT FOR CHAPTER 15 OF SHIPS GENERAL ORDERS****CHAPTER 15****BASIC CBRN AND DAMAGE CONTROL****1501. CBRN and Damage Control and in HMS/RFA**

- a. A general statement on the relevance and importance of CBRN Defence, including medical countermeasures.
- b. A statement on how Damage Control concerns all members of the ships company and embarked personnel.
- c. The requirement for all personnel to undertake Damage Control tasks outside their normal specialist duties.
- d. A brief explanation of the application of Damage Control in the particular ship, highlighting any deviations from normal RN/RFA practice.
- e. Cross references to Ship CBRNDC Orders - BRd 2170 (Volume 7) Series (see [Para 3403](#)), CB 4538 Series - CBRN Class Book, CB 9500 Series - Stability and Survivability Book and BRd 875 (for RFAs), as appropriate, stating the relationship of these Orders to each other.

1502. Ship Knowledge

- a. The importance of all personnel having good ship knowledge to enable them to react to emergencies at sea or in harbour.
- b. A summary of the ships CBRN and Damage Control and facilities with which personnel must be familiar.

1503. CBRN and Damage Control Organisation

- a. An explanation of the day-to-day administration of CBRN and Damage Control matters, including the role of HQ1/SCC and/or Gangway Watchkeepers.
- b. The roles of the SSEP and HFEP.

1504. Fire and Flood Prevention

- a. Attention to correct working practices.
- b. Cross reference to the welding and hotwork orders in SGO Chapter 2.

1505. Action to be Taken on Discovering Fire, Flood or Damage

- a. Alarm procedure.

- b. Actions to deal with the incident.

1506. Action to be Taken on Hearing a Fire, Flood or Damage Alarm

- a. Actions to be taken at the scene of the incident.
- b. General instructions for the ships company (SSEP and HFEP actions in CBRNDC Orders).
- c. Touch drill only for FRS call-out during exercises.

1507. Emergency Stations

- a. Instructions specific to Damage Control parties.
- b. Cross reference to SGO Chapter 2 for the general Emergency Stations and Liferaft Stations procedures.

1508. Clearing Away and Securing for Action

- a. Responsibility.
- b. Actions.
